
Quick guide to DB Primary

Login - Your child has an individual username and password



The home screen will look different depending on their class.

They will be able to see any new emails, blogs, surveys or tasks set on their home pages. They should click on any blogs or surveys that have been sent by teachers as they may contain important information. They should complete any set tasks if they see them on their home screen.



Tasks that have been set will look like this. Blogs and surveys will have their teacher's name on it



Children can send and receive emails within DB Primary. New emails will show on the home screen. The mail icon will also move about to alert them to new emails. Teachers may set some work by DB email.



Children can create their own blog and publish it for others to see and comment on.



The whistle appears in the top, left hand corner of the screen. Children know that they can 'blow the whistle' to alert an adult if they see something upsetting, worrying or if somebody has said something unkind or inappropriate. This goes

directly to a member of staff who will be able to take whatever action is required.

Learning Library



Learning library. Children can click on this icon to access games and activities for independent learning. They can choose from Maths, Computing, English, Topics and Games.

You can check the tasks are age appropriate by setting the correct year group. Click on the cog and then move the slider to the correct year. Don't forget to press save.

Communities

Children will be a member of their class community as well as the whole school community. They can access these from the communities tab on their home screens.

Class communities


Children can scroll down this page to find surveys and blogs. They are able to comment on the blogs, but must remember that others will be able to read their comments.



Along the top they will see a series of tabs: e-safety, wellbeing and fun stuff. They can explore these pages as much as they want. Sometimes teachers may set work linked to the activities and information on these pages.

Younger children may need more support to access the activities. We are adding to these pages all the time, so encourage children to keep looking.

Whole school community



This is where we can come together as a whole school. The community is set out in exactly the same way as the class communities.

Again, children can scroll down for surveys and blogs. Please encourage your child to take part in the surveys as this will to help us to ensure that their voice is part of our continuing curriculum development.
